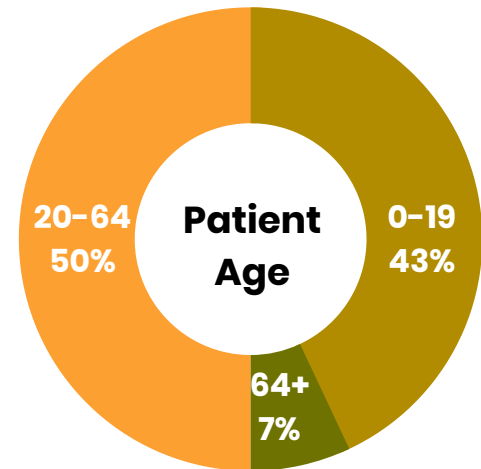
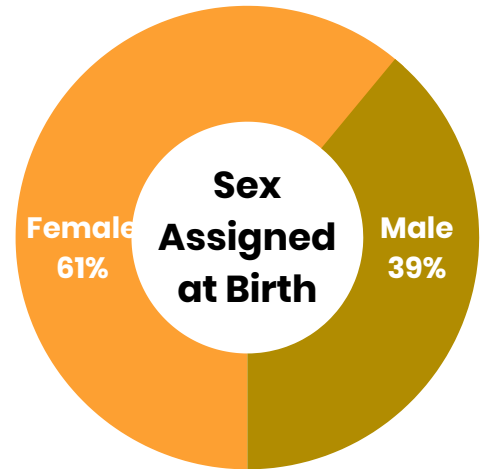
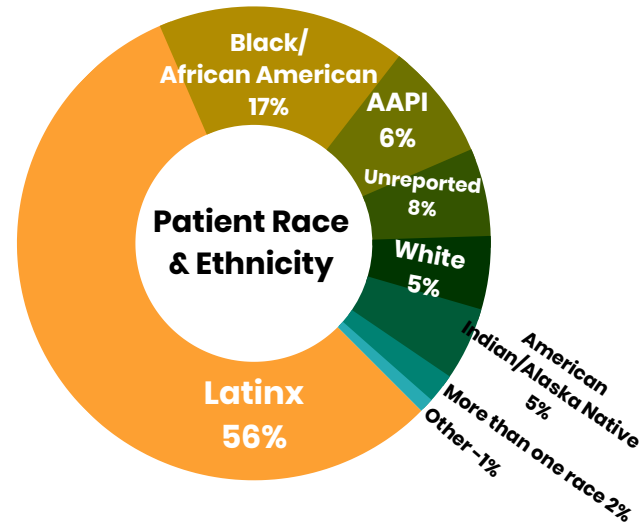
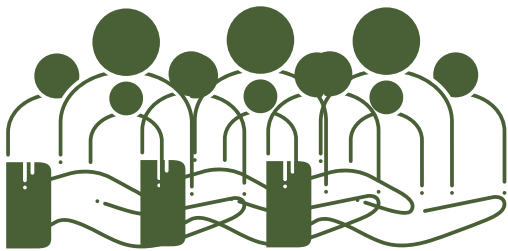
Mission Statement:

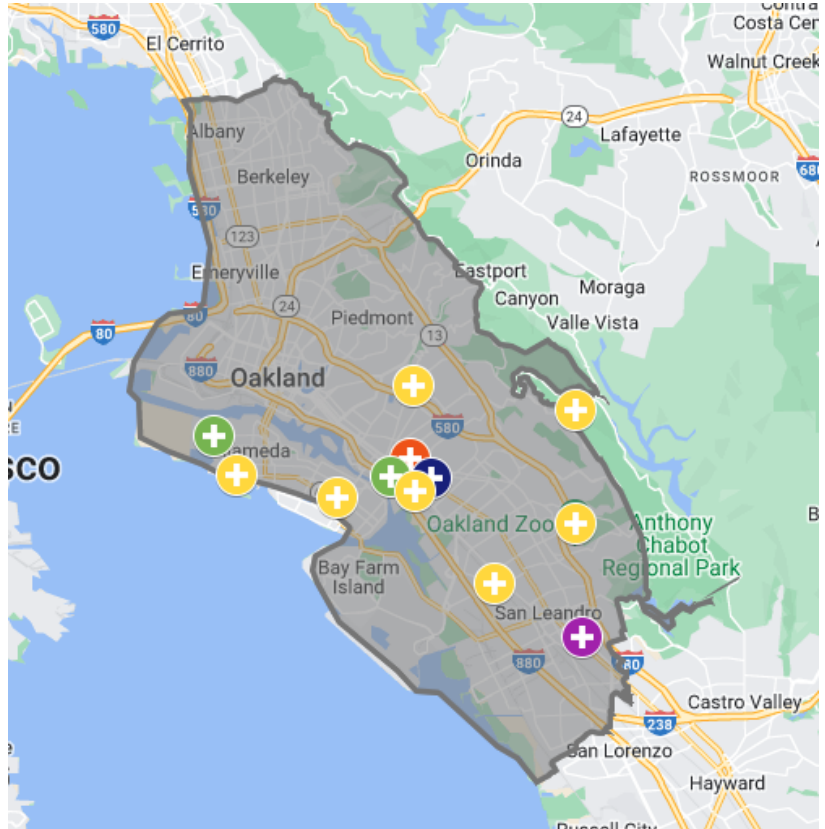

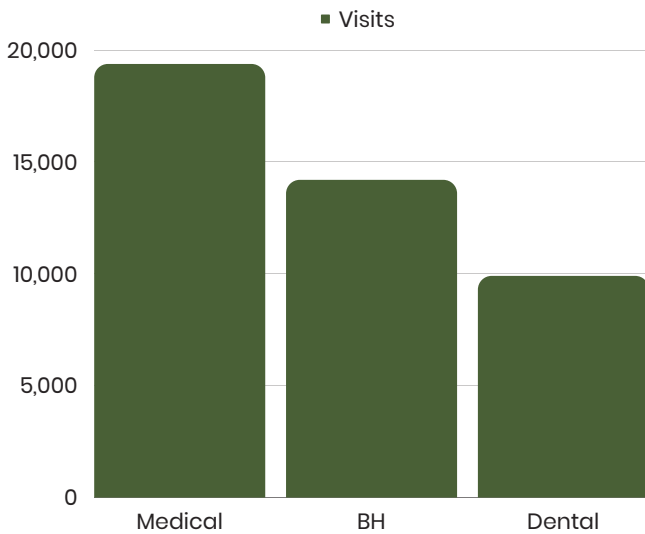
Visits:

In 2021 Native American Health Center provided more than 43,436 patient visits. Many of these visits addressed complex medical and behavioral needs, with patients accessing care an average of 6 visits in the year for a range of services, including: medical, dental, mental health, community health education and other patient services.
