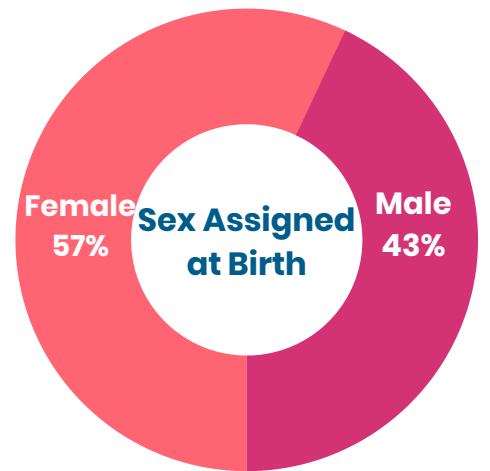
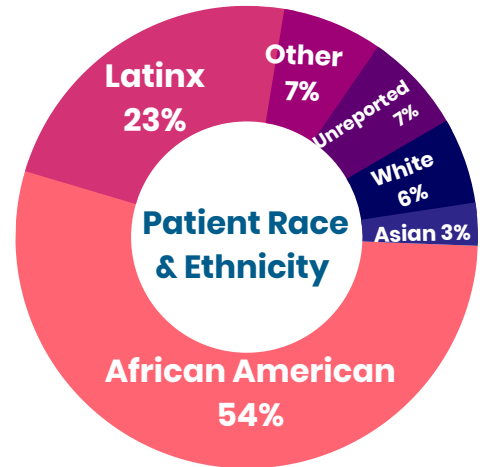
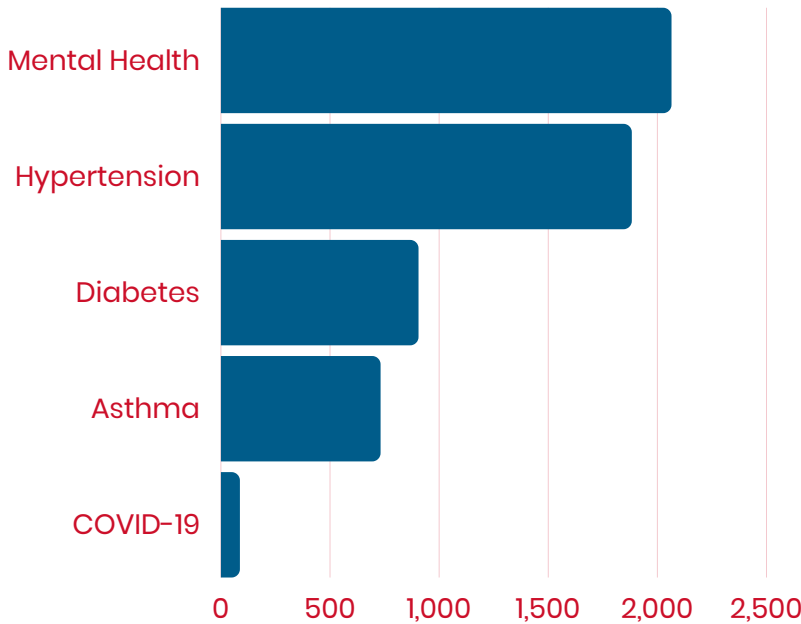




Mission Statement:

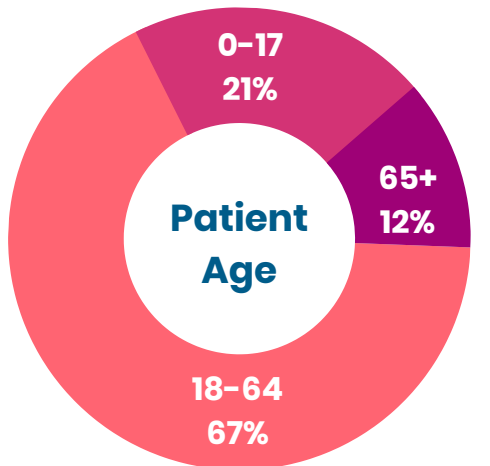

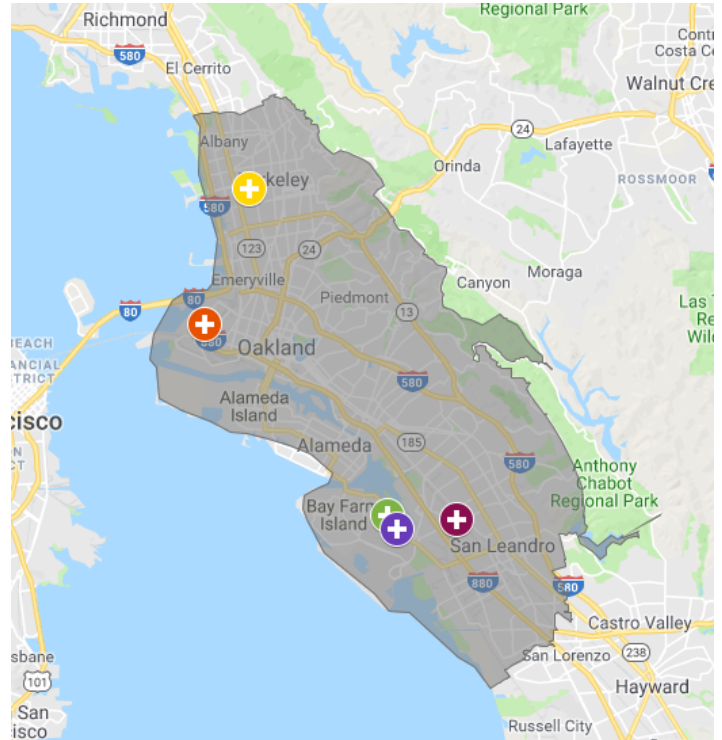
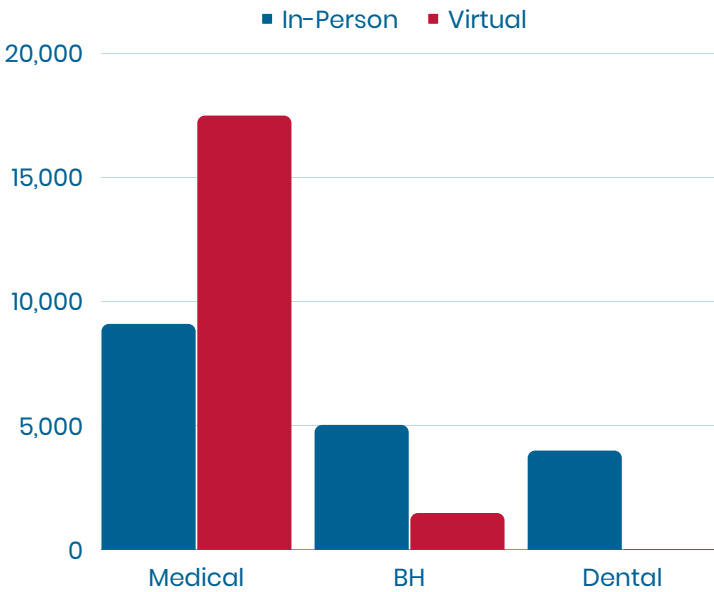
