WHAT IS THE RECALL ELECTION?

The 2021 California gubernatorial recall election is an upcoming special election on whether to recall current California Governor, Gavin Newsom. This election is scheduled for September 14, 2021, with every active, eligible voter set to receive a ballot at their address for the option to vote by mail, starting August 16, 2021. Your vote is your voice and every voice counts, so please make sure you're registered!

VOTING Q&A

Q: How can I vote in this election?

- A: All registered voters will received mail-in ballots and you have three ways to vote!
- 1. <u>BY MAIL</u>: Fill out your ballot, sign the back of the envelope and drop it in a mailbox near you by September 14, remember, you don't need a stamp!
 - 2. DROP BALLOT OFF: Drop your ballot off at any voting location in Alameda County by 8pm

3. VOTE IN PERSON: Find your in person voting location HERE or scan QR code
