Legislation

- AB 32 (Aguiar-Curry) – Retain the current telehealth and payment parity allowance indefinitely beyond the PHE.
 - Status: On the Governor’s desk, AHC will be submitting a letter of support:
- SB 966 (Limon) – Continue the PHE allowance that allows ASWs and AMFTs to bill and get reimbursed for face-to-face interventions.
 - Status: On the Governor’s desk, AHC will be submitting a letter of support:
- AB 204/SB 121 Workers Compensation – Budget trailer bill that will be directing \$70M for health center worker’s bonuses. CPCA was instrumental in shaping this proposal, details will be provided once it gets signed by the Governor.
 - Status: On the Governor’s desk, CPCA feels confident this will get approved.
- SPP Applications – The Supplemental Payment Program (SPP) application has been released by DHCS. The SPP was established to mitigate the financial losses due to the 340B program. Applications are due September 16th and details can be found [HERE](#).
