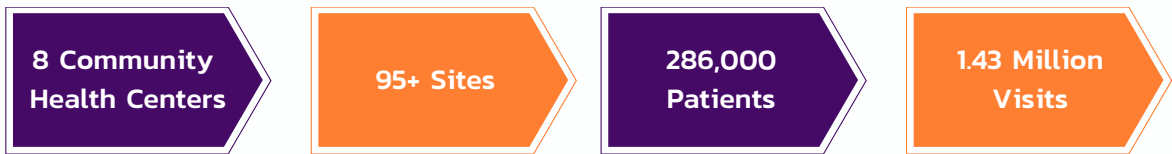




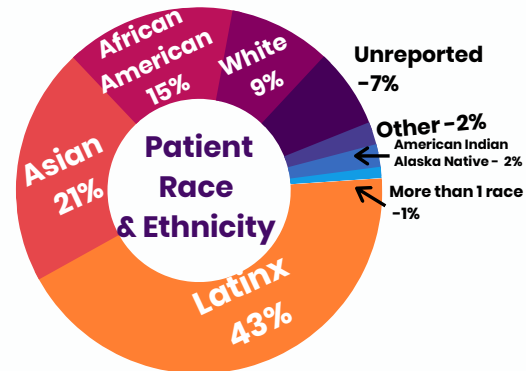

Health Center Patient Demographics, All Counties* Served

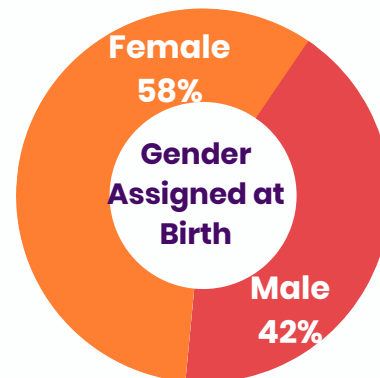
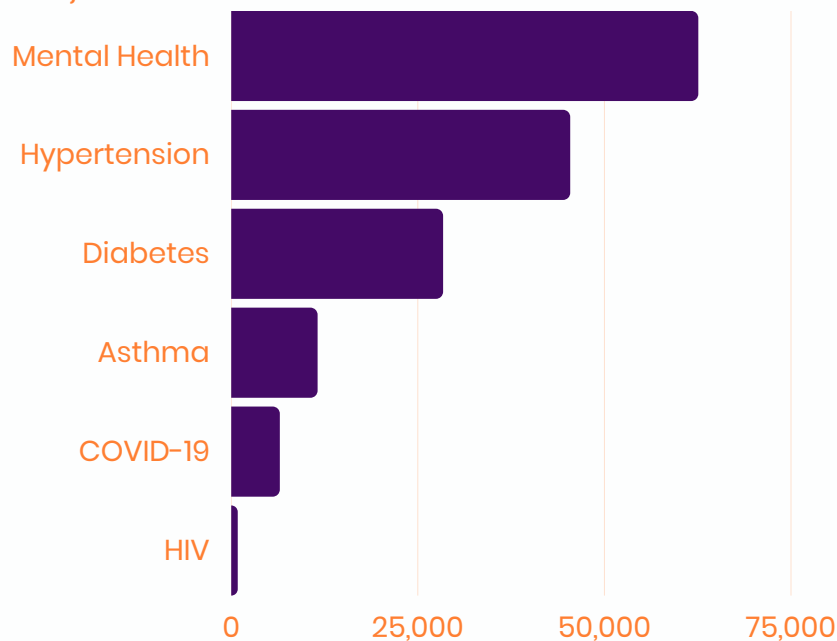


Mission Statement:

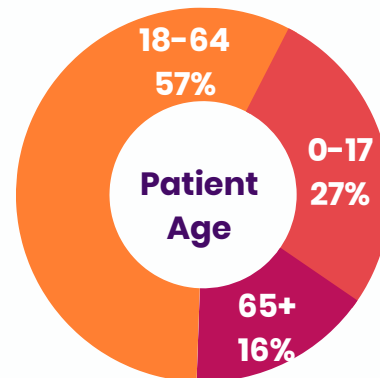

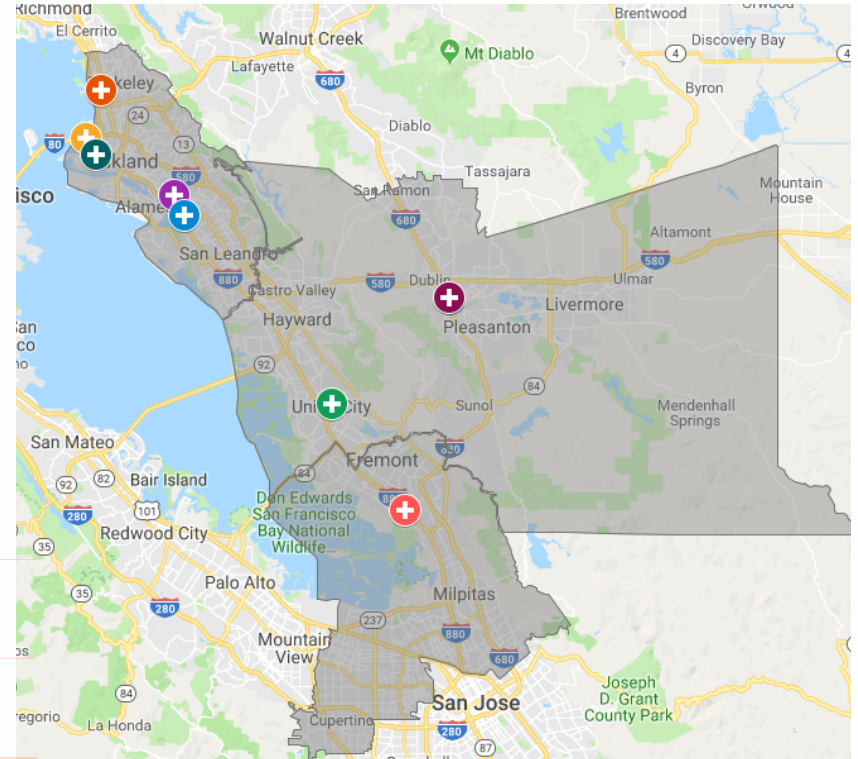

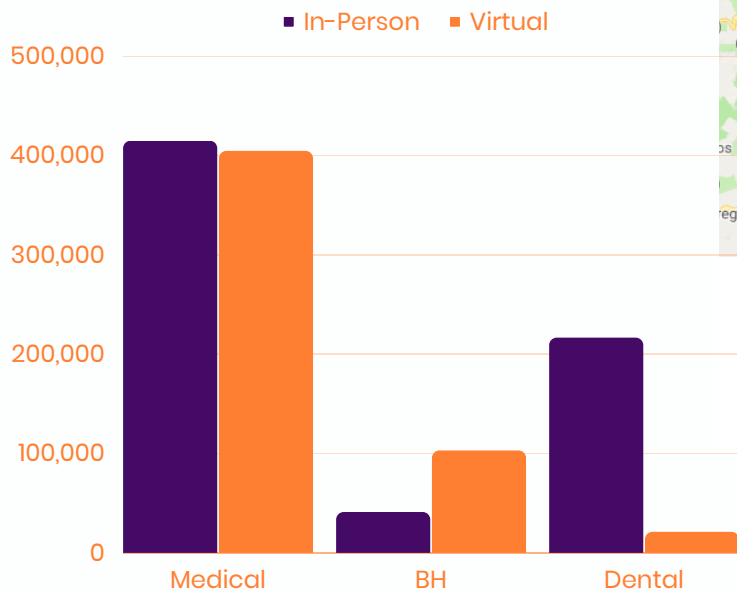

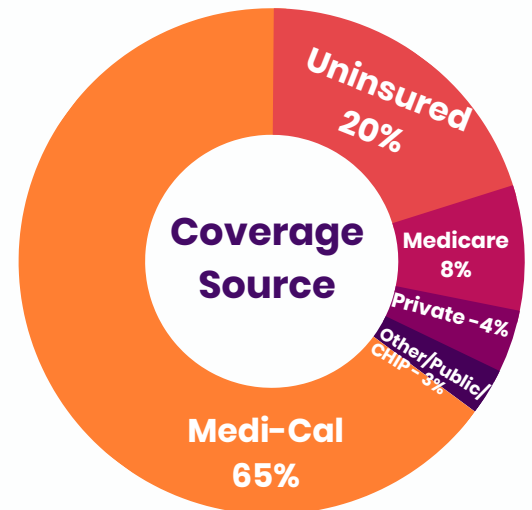
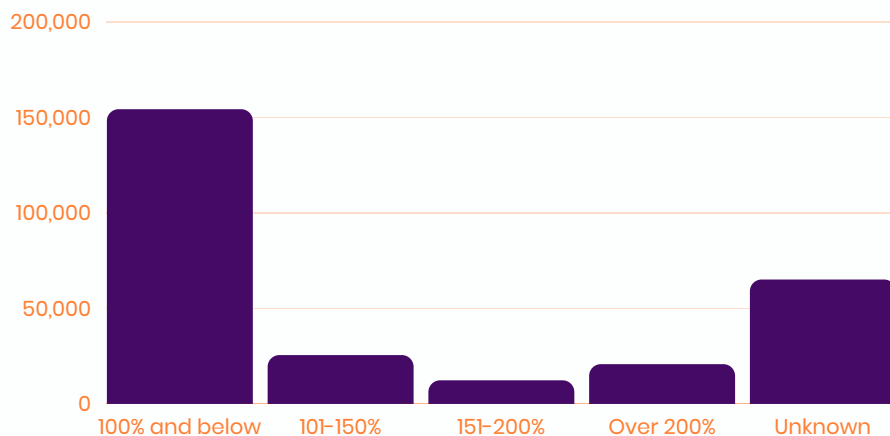
