




### **Mission Statement:**




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# **Health Center Patient Demographics**


### **Visits:**

In 2021 Bay Area Community Health provided more than 352,000 patient visits. Many of these visits addressed complex medical and behavioral needs, with patients accessing care an average of 5 visits in the year for a range of services, including: medical, dental, mental health, community health education and other patient services, both in clinic and virtually.
