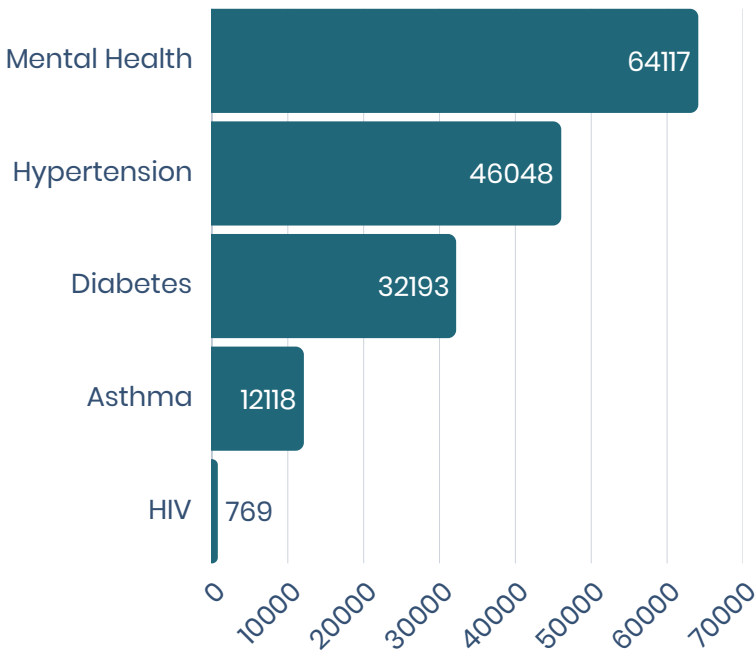

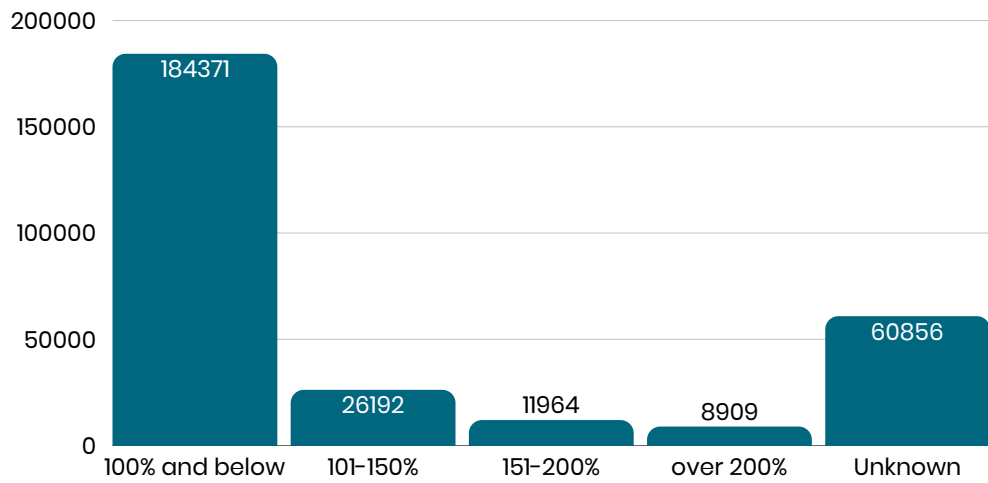

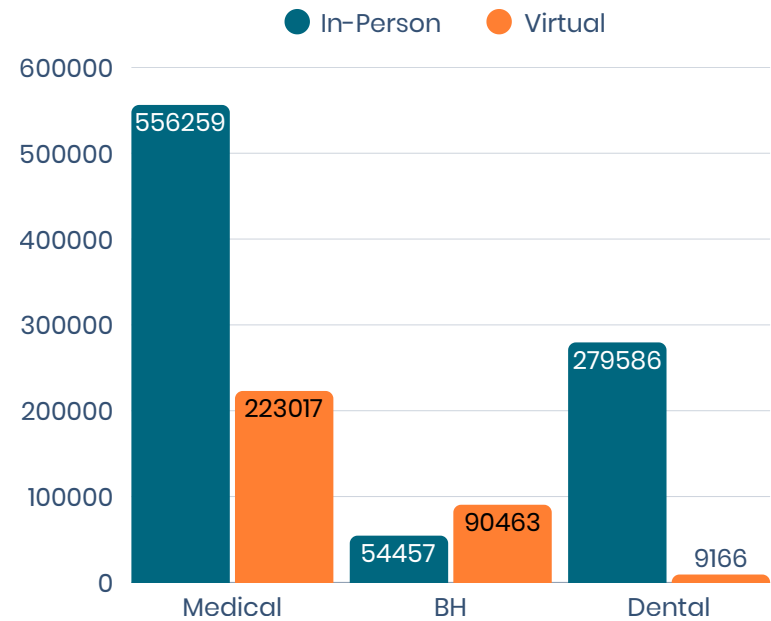
### 290,00 Patients Served in 2024
